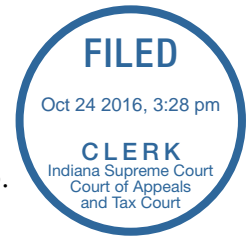

Order Granting Additional Senior Judge Service Days

The Honorable Terry C. Shewmaker, Judge of the Elkhart Circuit Court, has made a request to increase the number of senior judge service days allotted to his court for calendar year 2016.

And this Court, being duly advised, now finds that Judge Shewmaker has established sufficient reasons for the allotment of additional senior judge service days to his court.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED that the number of senior judge service days allotted to the Elkhart Circuit Court is increased from twenty (20) days to thirty (30) days for calendar year 2016. It is the responsibility of the presiding judge of the court to ensure that the number of senior judge service days allotted is not exceeded during the calendar year.
