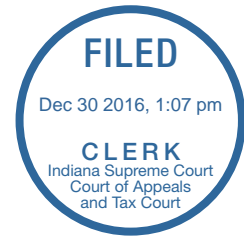

Order

Indiana Code 33-23-3-5, effective July 1, 2007, provides that a senior judge shall be entitled to a per diem of \$100 per day for each of the first thirty (30) days of senior judge service in a calendar year, and a per diem of \$250 for each day, up to one hundred days, the senior judge serves after the first thirty days of service in a calendar year, subject to the condition that this Court may issue an order adjusting the compensation rate for service beyond thirty (30) days.

The Court now finds that in 2017 the Court's payroll fund will be sufficient to compensate senior judges at the rate of \$250 per day as provided by statute.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED that, pursuant to IC 33-23-3-5(a)(2), during calendar year 2017 the compensation rate for senior judge service, beginning with the thirty-first (31st) day of service through the one-hundredth (100th) day of service will be \$250 for each day. This Order shall remain in effect until further order of the Court.
